



# Remember Rekindle Return

A 7-Day Journey Back to the Heart of the Father



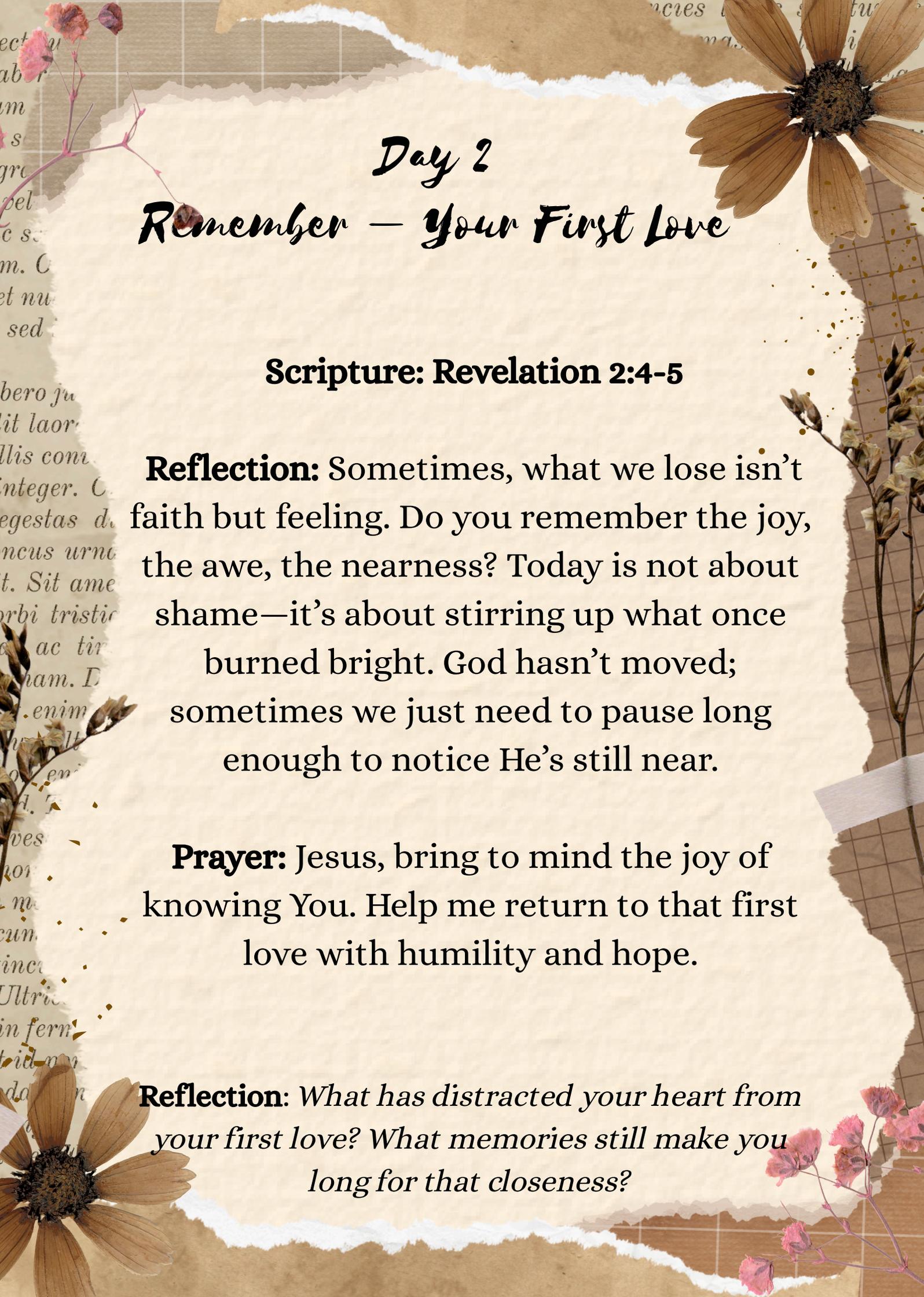
*Day 1*  
**Remember — The God Who Sees  
You**

**Scripture: Luke 15:20**

Before the son said a word, the Father saw him and ran. This is where relationship begins—with a God who notices you even in the distance. You are never out of His sight. Take a moment today to remember the first time you felt His love. This is the God who delights in seeing you, even before you have the words to speak or the strength to run.

**Prayer:** Father, help me remember the moments You were near. Stir my memory and awaken my heart again.

**Reflection:** *When was the first time you felt seen by God? What do you need to remember about His heart today?*



*Day 2*  
**Remember — Your First Love**

**Scripture: Revelation 2:4-5**

**Reflection:** Sometimes, what we lose isn't faith but feeling. Do you remember the joy, the awe, the nearness? Today is not about shame—it's about stirring up what once burned bright. God hasn't moved; sometimes we just need to pause long enough to notice He's still near.

**Prayer:** Jesus, bring to mind the joy of knowing You. Help me return to that first love with humility and hope.

**Reflection:** *What has distracted your heart from your first love? What memories still make you long for that closeness?*

## *Return – The Father Still Waits*

**Scripture: Hosea 6:1**

**Reflection:** We often think we have to fix ourselves before coming back. But the Father isn't waiting for perfection. He's waiting for surrender. Return doesn't begin with striving. It begins with turning. Like the prodigal, you don't need to bring an apology - just your heart.

**Prayer:** Lord, I turn my heart back to You. I return not with excuses, but with expectation. I love you.

**Reflection:** *What's been holding you back from returning fully? What would it look like to surrender today?*

Day 4

# Return — No Shame in His Presence

**Scripture: Psalm 34:5**

**Reflection:** "Those who look to Him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame." God doesn't use shame to bring you home. His kindness leads you to repentance. His grace welcomes you. Where shame tells you to hide, grace says, "Come close."

**Prayer:** God, remove the fear that keeps me from You. I believe You run toward me, not away. I return with hope.

**Reflection:** *How has shame shaped your view of God? What truth from Scripture do you need to believe today?*

Day 5

## Rekindle – Stir the Flame

**Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:6**

**Reflection:** What once burned bright may feel dim now. But fire can be stirred. Passion can be renewed. Faith can come alive again. It won't always feel dramatic. Sometimes, it begins with a spark—a quiet yes, a whispered prayer, a lifted gaze.

**Prayer:** Holy Spirit, breathe on what feels cold in me. Rekindle the flame of love, intimacy, and trust.

**Reflection:** *What parts of your faith feel cold or quiet? Invite God to stir them again.*

Day 6  
**Rekindle – Communion, Not  
Performance**

**Scripture: John 15:5**

**Reflection:** God didn't invite you into religion. He called you into abiding. Relationship with Him is not built on doing, but on being with. Rekindling starts not with effort but with presence. In the stillness, we are reminded that we were made for communion, not achievement.

**Prayer:** Jesus, let me rest in You. Teach me how to stay close, not by works, but by love.

**Reflection:** *Are you abiding or just performing?  
What can you let go of today to rest in Him?*

Day 7

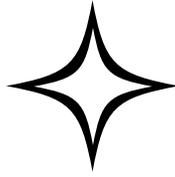
## You Are Yahweh's Delight

**Scripture: Zephaniah 3:17**

**Reflection:** You are not barely accepted. You are deeply delighted in. The Father rejoices over you with singing. That's where this journey leads—not just to faith, but to delight. You are not a burden or a disappointment. You are the joy set before Him.

**Prayer:** Father, help me believe I am Your delight. Let that truth shape how I live, love, and come home again.

**Reflection:** *What would change in your life if you truly believed you are His delight?*
